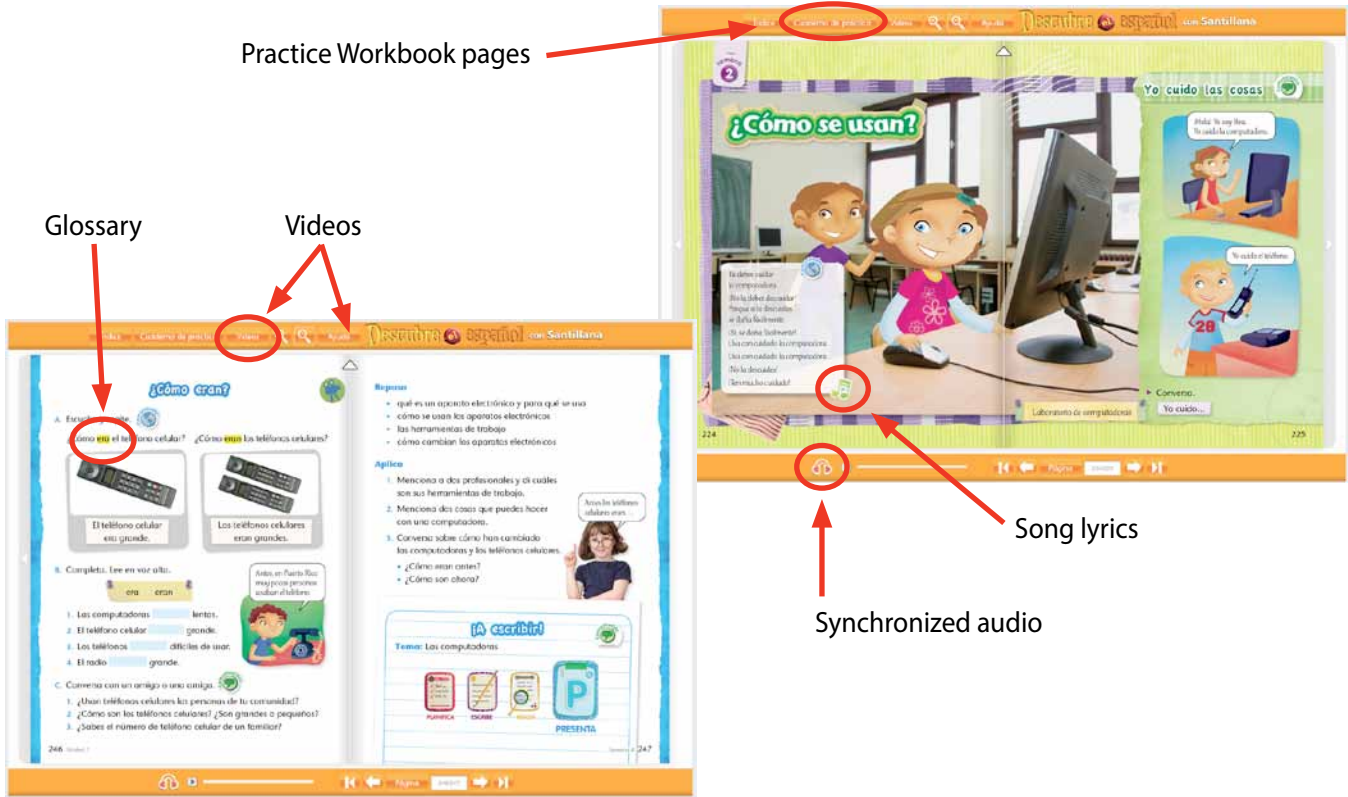
1. Once you've received your access code, log on to santillanana.schoology.com
2. Sign in (using the username and password you created), navigate to the top menu bar and click on the Courses tab.



3. Select the course name: **Santillana Demo Course 2016-2017**

4. Select the *Descubre el español* folder to view the eLearning Center resources for any level. Select the level of your choice.
